#### ELIGIBILITY

SUNLIFE's CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES of New Brunswick Road Racing is open to all runners who are residents of the province.

#### AWARDS

Awards will be presented in the following categories: Top 10 Open Men Top 3 Females Top 3 Masters (age 40 and over)

Certificates will be given to all runners who receive a total of 3 or more points.

#### RULES

-Points will be awarded based on finish position in race:

First	- 30	Fourth	- 20	Seventh	- 17	T 11 14
Second	- 25	Fifth	÷ 19	Eighth	- 16	Tenth - 14 And so on
Third	- 22	Sixth	- 18	Ninth	- 15	

- Any finisher will receive at least one point.

- Record breaking performances will receive 5 points.

- Total score at the end of the season will be based on the eight best race results (if more than eight races are run).

- The highest point scorer in each division will be declared Provincial Road Race Champion.

All others who score more than three points will receive a provincial standing.

- To be eligible for a ranking, runners must be New Brunswick residents.
